

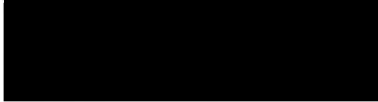

Re: Justice Against Sponsors in Terrorism Act (JASTA) Lawsuit Consent Form

Dear Mr. [REDACTED]:

You were previously notified about your eligibility to proceed with a lawsuit against the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and other sponsors of terrorism under the Justice Against Sponsors in Terrorism Act (JASTA). You previously retained my office to represent you for claims relating to your 9/11 injuries. The attorneys and staff who are now at Napoli Shkolnik have been proudly representing you and will proceed with your lawsuit under JASTA upon receipt of your consent.

I was appointed by the United States District Court as Plaintiffs' Liaison Counsel representing more than 11,000 first responders and other rescue and recovery workers, and you, who were injured during the rescue, recovery and debris-removal activities at the World Trade Center in the months following 9/11. I was instrumental in obtaining settlements that are today valued at more than \$816 million for my clients. I also lobbied New York State and the U.S. Congress for two important pieces of legislation to assist injured workers and residents. These include an amendment to New York's General Municipal Law §50-1 ("JIMMY NOLAN'S LAW") that provided a one-year savings statute for otherwise time-barred first responder claims and the JAMES ZADROGA 9/11 HEALTH AND COMPENSATION ACT OF 2010 ("Zadroga Bill"), which provides for medical monitoring and cash awards for injured first responders, local office workers and community members injured by the post-9/11 fallout. I also helped pass the Re-Opened Victim's Compensation Fund and process many of its claims.

Additionally, I was profiled in the published book "City of Dust," a journalistic account of the rescue, recovery and debris-removal activities at the site of the World Trade Center following the September 11, 2001 attacks, authored by former *New York Times* columnist Anthony DePalma.

In addition to myself, Napoli Shkolnik has the people who have been working on your case and these cases since this suit began more than 15 years ago. Those same people still proudly represent you today.

If you would like Napoli Shkolnik to file a lawsuit on your behalf under JASTA pursuant to the same terms you had with my office subject to any modifications by statute, court or between the parties, please sign and return the enclosed Consent Form in the return envelope and Napoli Shkolnik will proceed with your claim.
